## NOBO JATRA NEW BEGINNING

**USAID'S Development Food Security Activity** 









"Nobo Jatra" is a five year USAID Food for Peace Title II Development Food Security Activity, implemented by World Vision Bangladesh along with it's consortium partners Winrock International (WI) and World Food Programme (WFP) from September 2015 to September 2020 for achieving the goal - "Improved Gender Equitable Food Security, Nutrition and Resilience of Vulnerable People in four Upazilas (sub-districts) under two districts of south west Bangladesh". Recently, Nobo Jatra's MCHN Component has observed National Nutrition Week from 23rd to 29th April 2018 to create mass awareness on nutrition within the poor communities in the project's working area for those who do not have appropriate knowledge about nutritious food locally available to meet their demand. Nobo Jatra recognized that most nutritional deficiencies are not directly related to poverty, but a rather lack of awareness, proper hygiene and nutritional knowledge. Leveraging on community interest and innovating dissemination methods, Nobo latra celebrates this year's theme - "While thinking about food, think about Nutrition too".
